For those interested in skiing Monarch Mountain, we suggest purchasing lift tickets and rentals now at www.SkiMonarch.com. We encourage using Tuesday and/or Wednesday as ski days; however, feel free to ski any day you prefer. Keep in mind that Sky Ranch Horn Creek is situated at 9,000 ft above sea level. Monarch Mountain is over 11,000 ft. Staying on camp Monday to relax and acclimate is advised.

The drive from Sky Ranch Horn Creek to Monarch Mountain takes approximately one hour and forty minutes. An early continental breakfast will be made available in the lodge dining hall for any families going off-site earlier than 8:00 am. A sack lunch will also be available in the dining hall to take with you on your day out.

Lift tickets, rentals, and transportation to Monarch Mountain is not provided by Sky Ranch. Be sure to plan accordingly.

DIRECTIONS

You can find maps for Sky Ranch Horn Creek by visiting our website, www.SkyRanch.org, and clicking on the "Locations" tab on the "About" page. Horn Creek is off of Highway 69. There are signs that will help guide you to camp. Turn onto CR 140, then turn left onto Macey Ln (CR 129). Turn right on CR 130 and follow this all the way to camp. We do not recommend turning off of Highway 69 onto CR 130 because this section of road is not paved. If you are flying into Colorado, we recommend arriving at Colorado Springs Airport, which is 2 hours away.

CLIMATE AND WEATHER

Sky Ranch Horn Creek enjoys over 300 days of sunshine each year and a cool, dry climate. March daytime highs are typically in the 40s. Lows are below freezing. Temperatures at camp are usually lower than the town of Westcliffe. Dress warm with lots of layers. And walk carefully around camp, being mindful of wet or icy surfaces.

Gains in altitude can affect anyone, especially when traveling above 7,000 feet. The effects of high altitude can include breathlessness, fatigue, headaches, difficulty sleeping, swelling of the hands, face, or feet, nausea, or vomiting. To reduce your symptoms, avoid strenuous activity for the first day or two of your visit, and drink extra water before and during your visit. Check with your doctor before going to high altitude if you have a heart or lung condition.
