

On September 5, 2025, the State of Texas took historic steps to strengthen youth camp safety in the wake of this summer's tragic flash flood in the Hill Country. Two major pieces of legislation – Senate Bill 1, known as the Heaven's 27 Camp Safety Act, and House Bill 1, the Youth CAMPER Act – were officially signed into law. These new statewide safety requirements are expected to be finalized in January and will be incorporated into Sky Ranch's existing safety protocols.

Safety has always been at the heart of who we are. Because of our longstanding commitment to risk management and emergency preparedness, Sky Ranch already meets most of the standards included in the forthcoming legislation. Even so, we welcome these new measures as another opportunity to strengthen the care and protection we provide to every child entrusted to us. Once our updated safety guidelines and emergency response plans receive final approval from state and local authorities, we will make them fully available for all camper families to review.
